Getting Started

- Children start kindergarten in the 12 months prior to school. All children will begin kindergarten in January – attend until December and begin at your school of choice the following January. Your child is eligible to start in January if they turn 4 before May 1st.
- Aboriginal children are eligible to start from 3 years of age.
- Parents of children with additional needs can talk to the Director about early entry. There may be some opportunity as resources permit for early entry to kindergarten.
- Sessions are comprised of 2 full days and one half day each fortnight. Your choices are all or some sessions in the Purple Group or Green Group.

Monday 8.45 – 3.30 "KOALAS"	Tuesday 8.45 – 3.30	Fortnightly Friday 8.45 -11.45 weeks 1,3,5,7,9,11 in Term 1. In terms 2 and 3 your child will have a Friday morning session in weeks 2,4,6,8,10. In term 4 the sessions will fall in weeks 2,4,6,8, as the year concludes in week 9.
Wednesday 8.45 – 3.30 "POSSUMS"	Thursday 8.45 – 3.30	Fortnightly Friday 8.45 – 11.45 am weeks 2,4,6,8,10 in term 1. During terms 2,3 and 4 your child will have a Friday morning session in weeks 1,3,5,7,9.

- A priority of access policy applies to sessions and lunch care. *In the event that we are full* we prioritize local families.
- Term 1 of kindergarten sessions costs \$70 and lasts for 10 weeks.
- A preliminary enrolment form can be completed over the phone or after a short discussion
 with the Director about your child's start date. A complete enrolment package is a long
 document where personal confidential information is requested, this is best completed with
 the guidance of a staff member. We will offer information sessions about starting
 kindergarten In October this is when we ask you to complete the enrolment package.
